

Entangled Publishing released Linda's two romantic adventures, Alive at 5 and Cuba Undercover as well as her medical thriller, Flatline. Think James Bond meets Romancing the Stone. Her latest series takes a darker turn, investigative thrillers, starting with All the Broken Girls. All the Missing Girls and The Phantom Pirate of Gasparilla release in late 2024 and early 2025. She has won 13 Emmy awards, numerous Society of Professional Journalist and Associated Press awards, as well as a Florida Bar and an Edward R. Murrow award. This former baton-twirling beauty queen from the deep south, (Go Dawgs!), now lives in Tampa with her husband. They've raised five kids, a surgeon, a nurse, a paramedic, a pilot, and a future psychologist. Fair to say they'll be taken care of in retirement.
